RE: Dogwood District/Authority Awards

The RSS Dogwood District Scholarship Committee needs your help in identifying any students who may be eligible for a district scholarship. The Dogwood District Scholarships are used to further a student's post secondary education. Last year RSS had 26 winners of \$1,000.

The Requirements for Eligibility:

- 1. Student must be in Grade 12 and in a position to graduate in the current school year.
2. All students who submit an application for the Dogwood District Scholarship Award Program must demonstrate a "skill" to the school level Dogwood District Scholarship Committee. This skill could be a compilation of work done in the one of the following areas: Fine Arts (Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, and Music), or Applied Skills (Business Education, Technology, and Home Economics), Physical Activity, including but not limited to PE, and Second Languages. The key element to this is that the students must demonstrate a learned "skill."
3. Students must have a specialty area in which they excel.
4. A career goal that matches or goes hand in hand with a specialty area.
5. Financial need will not be considered as a criterion in awarding a District Dogwood Scholarship.
6. Students may be awarded both a Provincial Scholarship and a Dogwood District

Please submit students' names that you personally recommend for the Dogwood District Scholarship awards in your area by Wednesday April 23rd. We will be contacting you once all submissions have been handed in.
